Representative Cases

Commercial, Corporate, Financial

1. M v C

Arbitration – Instructed for Claimant in Switzerland on a complex multi-jurisdictional €70 million corporate loan dispute.

2. F v G

Arbitration – Instructed by Claimant, an international private equity group, concerning an investment in Asia Pacific and a dispute under a shareholders' agreement. The dispute value amounts to USD\$70 million.

3. P v T

Arbitration – Instructed by Claimant on a private equity dispute in Asia Pacific. The dispute value amounts to USD\$50 million.

Construction & Engineering & Infrastructure

4. B v M

Arbitration – Instructed for Claimant in a USD\$112 million dam reservoir construction dispute in Africa.

5. G v B

Arbitration – Instructed for the Claimant in a USD\$50 million water conveyance aquifer construction dispute in the Middle East.
